There is a clear link between attendance and attainment at school, with those students who have poor attendance being less likely to achieve good GCSE grades, and more likely not to be in education, employment or training when they leave school.

We are here to support students and their Parents / Carers to ensure that they maximise their potential and to enable them to overcome any barriers preventing them from attending.

What is 'Good' Attendance?

All students should aim for a target of at least 97% attendance, this equates to 6 days absence in an academic year.



Any student whose absence falls below 90% is deemed persistently absent from school.

What is your child's attendance like?

Regular Attendance at school really does matter!

Did you know that children with over 90% attendance are more likely to gain 5 or more A-C GCSE's or equivalent qualifications?

Did you know that children with less than 85% attendance are unlikely to gain 5 A-C GCSE's or any qualifications?

Please remember it is your responsibility to ring school if your child is not attending. This helps to keep children safe.

Please try to make any appointments after school hours.




How do you think 90% attendance will affect a student's chances of doing well in KS4 exams?

Research suggests 19 days missed from school (90% attendance) equates to a drop of 1 GCSE grade in every subject.

What impact does attendance have on final grades? Here's how our Y11's did last year...

Attendance percentage	Percentage of pupils achieving 5 A* - C grades	Percentage of pupils achieving 5 A* - C grades - including English, Maths and Science	Average Grade per student
> 95%	82%	82%	B+
< 85%	29%	21%	E+

Students with high attendance get better qualifications.



Missing Minutes

Arriving 5 minutes late every day adds up to over 3 days lost each year!

Arriving 15 minutes late every day is the same as being absent for 2 weeks a year!

Arriving 30 minutes late every day is the same as being absent for 19 days a year. This is equal to 90% attendance just for being late!
